


### **Updates from Kathy**

## **Age-Friendly Innovation**

The Livability Index & Age-Friendly DC

In 2015, AARP developed a tool to assess community livability / age-friendliness. The "Livability Index" represents an objective measure to better understand how "neighborhoods" fare on measures of age-friendliness.

With an overall score of 58 out of 100 for all of DC, the Livability Index verified issues needing improvement, such as affordable housing. Among the nation's first age-friendly community to apply the tool for its broadscale usage, the findings are being incorporated into their strategic age-friendly planning.
